DONATIONS POLICY

Caistor Town Council may choose to set aside a sum of money each year, as determined at the Precept Meeting and approved by the full Council, which can be made available as grants to organisations within the area served by the Town Council of Caistor, or individuals who reside within that area.

Grants may be given for the benefit of the community in so far as the Town Council has the power to do so. Grants will not normally be given to provide funds for projects which would normally fall under the remit of the statutory bodies.

- The Town Council may use all, a proportion, or none of the funding set aside in any year.
- The Town Council will consider all written applications as they are received.
- The Town Council will consider applications for grants in confidential session.

Applicants must state in their application:-

- The purpose for which the grant will be used.
 - How the individual or organisation and community will benefit from the project to which the grant may be given.
 - The total cost of the project.
 - How the organisation or individual intends to raise other funding to finance the project.

Unsuccessful applicants may re-apply in subsequent years – although they will receive no preferential consideration over and above other applications.
